

ORDINANCE NO. 94-222

SECTION 4-3-4.1. "YARD RUBBISH PREPARATION EXCEPTIONS"

(a) Yard rubbish will be allowed to be placed for pick-up provided it is enclosed in approved containers.* There shall be no limitation on the number of approved containers placed for pick-up which contain only yard rubbish. Tree branches and heavy brush which cannot be containerized shall not exceed four (4) feet in length or eight (8) inches in diameter and shall be neatly stacked; no further preparation shall be required. Bulky objects such as furniture or appliances shall be neatly stacked; no further preparation shall be required . . .

*Section 4-3-1. "Definitions."

(1) APPROVED GARBAGE OR RUBBISH CONTAINER

A watertight paper or plastic bag or garbage or rubbish can which when full does not exceed 50 pounds in weight.

(2) GARBAGE OR RUBBISH CAN

A watertight, rustproof metal or plastic receptacle or container of substantial construction, having a holding capacity of not less than fifteen (15) nor more than thirty (30) gallons, and equipped with a tight fitting lid or cover and with one (1) or more handles or grips by which the receptacle or container may be conveniently lifted or moved.

(3) PAPER BAG

A bag made especially for the containment of garbage having a wire, string or other method of keeping the bag tightly sealed at all times, except when garbage is being deposited.

(4) PLASTIC BAG

A polyethylene bag, having not less than fifteen (15) gallons not more than thirty (30) gallons in capacity, which is especially designed for the disposal of garbage and has a wire, string or other method to keep the bag tightly sealed at all times, except when garbage is being deposited.
